Beavertown Brewery (De Beauvoir, Hackney, London) was established in December 2011 by Logan Plant and Byron Knight in Duke's Brew and Que bar and restaurant. The hot liquor tank, mash tun and copper were installed in the kitchen opposite the two smokers of the BBQ and ran at 4BBL per brew (650 litres - 1150 pints).

Due to lack of space fermentation, casking and bottling were carried out a few hundred yards down the road in a lock-up garage. The success of the brewery resulted in a move to new, larger premises in Hackney Wick at the beginning of March 2013.
